Mobile health services offered at 10 sites in the county in March

SARASOTA COUNTY — The Florida Department of Health in Sarasota County's (DOH-Sarasota) Health In Motion Mobile Medical Unit staff will provide free and low-cost health services at 10 sites around the county during March. The mobile medical unit staff will also be present at three special events. These include

the Sarasota Springfest event that will take place on Saturday, March 1 from 9 a.m.-3 p.m. at Palmer Ranch, located at 5849 Sawyer Loop (near Clark Road), the 'Lifestyles After 50' Fun Fest on Wednesday, March 5 from 10 a.m.-3 p.m. at Venice Community Center, 326 Nokomis Ave. S. in Venice. Mobile health services will also be provided at the Veterans' Appreciation Fair on Friday, March 29 from 9:30 a.m.-Noon at Sarasota Military Academy, 801 N. Orange Ave. in Sarasota.



The services offered include diabetes education and screening, blood pressure tests, pregnancy testing, HIV testing, body mass index (BMI) measurement, adult immunizations and health education; however, not all services, including immunizations, are offered at all sites.

The staff also assists individuals who lack medical insurance and do not have a health care provider to find a medical home for ongoing health care.

No appointment is needed. Some services are free, including HIV rapid testing with results in 20 minutes. Other services are provided on a sliding-fee scale based on income. A registered nurse is available at all sites.

While these services are most often provided in a 40-foot-long bus, there are times when services are provided inside the facilities visited.
