# Mobile health services offered at 15 county sites and three special events in August

The Sarasota County Health Department's Health In Motion Mobile Medical Unit staff will provide free and low-cost health services at 15 sites around the county and at three special events during August.

In the first special event, staff members will participate in the sixth annual Ready, Set, Grow! Infant to Kindergarten Family Fair on Saturday, Aug. 6 from 10 a.m.-2 p.m. at the Westfield Sarasota Square Mall, 8201 S. Tamiami Trail, Sarasota. The following services will be provided: height/weight and body mass index (BMI) screening, blood pressure and blood sugar checks, and HIV testing.

Health In Motion staff also will be present at the eighth annual Back to School Resource Fair on Saturday, Aug. 13, from 9 a.m.-12:30 p.m. at the Morgan Family Community Center, 6207 W. Price Blvd., North Port. Vision screening, height/weight and blood pressure checks will be available at that location.

As part of the First Stop CITGO Customer Appreciation Fair, the Health In Motion staff will provide HIV and Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) testing, as well as blood pressure and blood sugar checks. The event will take place on Friday, Aug. 19, from 1-6 p.m. at the First Stop CITGO gas station at the corner of 10<sup>th</sup> Street and Washington Boulevard (U.S. 301) in Sarasota.

The services offered at the 15 regularly established sites include diabetes education and screening, blood pressure tests, pregnancy testing, HIV and tuberculosis testing, adult immunizations and health education. The staff also assists individuals who lack medical insurance and do not have a health care provider to find a medical home for ongoing health care.

No appointment is needed. Some services are free, including HIV rapid testing with results in 20 minutes. Other services are provided on a sliding-fee scale based on income. A registered nurse is available at all sites.
