Free and low-cost health services will be provided in March at 16 Sarasota County sites and two special events

The Sarasota County Health Department's Health In Motion Mobile Medical Unit staff will provide free and low-cost health services at 16 sites around the county during March.

The Health In Motion staff also will participate in two special events during March. The "Get Ready for Spring" Medical Screening Day will take place from 10 a.m.-2 p.m. Friday, March 11, at the Siesta Key Beach Pavilion, 948 Beach Road, Sarasota. The event will feature free skin cancer screenings, blood pressure and blood sugar checks, as well as HIV rapid testing. All services at this event are free.

The second special event, the Sarasota Springfest 2011, is scheduled from 8:30 a.m.-4 p.m. Saturday, March 19, at Palmer Ranch at the corner of Sawyer Loop and Northridge roads off Clark Road in Sarasota. A range of health screenings will be offered at no cost at this event.

The services offered at all regularly established sites include diabetes education and screening, blood pressure tests, pregnancy testing, HIV and tuberculosis testing, adult immunizations and health education. The staff also assists individuals who lack medical insurance and do not have a health care provider in finding a medical home for ongoing health care.

No appointment is needed. Some services are free, including HIV rapid testing with results in 20 minutes. Other services are provided on a sliding-fee scale based on income. Licensed volunteer physicians from the Senior Friendship Centers provide basic medical care when the mobile medical unit is at the Salvation Army in Sarasota. A registered nurse is available at all sites.
