Mobile health services offered at 16 county sites and two special events in November

The Sarasota County Health Department's Health In Motion Mobile Medical Unit staff will provide free and low-cost health services at 16 sites around the county during November.

The Health In Motion staff also will be at two special events during November:

- Venice Fall Wellness Fair at Venice Community Center, 326 Nokomis Ave. S. on Wednesday, Nov. 9, from 10 a.m.-2 p.m.
- Fall Wellness Fair and Farmer's Market at the Sandra Sims Terry Community Center, 509 Collins Road in Laurel on Friday, Nov. 18, from 1-5 p.m.

The staff will provide blood pressure and blood sugar screenings and assist people in locating a primary care provider.

The services offered at the 16 established sites include diabetes education and screening, blood pressure tests, pregnancy testing, HIV and tuberculosis testing, adult immunizations and health education. The staff also helps people who lack medical insurance and don't have a health care provider find a medical home for ongoing health care.

No appointment is needed. Some services are free, including HIV rapid testing with results in 20 minutes. Other services are provided on a sliding-fee scale based on income. A registered nurse is available at all sites.
