## **Mobile health services offered at 16 county sites in October**

The Sarasota County Health Department's Health In Motion Mobile Medical Unit staff will provide free and low-cost health services at 16 sites around the county during October. In addition, the Health In Motion staff will be present at the First Hispanic Church of Sarasota on Saturday, Oct. 15, from 10 a.m.-2 p.m. to provide HIV rapid testing as part of the National Latino AIDS Awareness Day observance.

The services offered at the 16 regularly established sites include diabetes education and screening, blood pressure tests, pregnancy testing, HIV and tuberculosis testing, adult immunizations and health education. The staff also assists individuals who lack medical insurance and do not have a health care provider to find a medical home for ongoing health care.

No appointment is needed. Some services are free, including HIV rapid testing with results in 20 minutes. Other services are provided on a sliding-fee scale based on income. A registered nurse is available at all sites.
