## **Mobile health services offered at 15 county sites and two community events during January**

The Sarasota County Health Department's Health In Motion Mobile Medical Unit staff will provide free and low-cost health services at 15 sites around the county during January. The staff also will be present at two special events:

- Saturday, Jan. 14, from 10 a.m.-2 p.m., Suncoast Lifestyle Expo at the Sarasota Bradenton International Convention Center, 8005 15<sup>th</sup> St. in Sarasota
- Friday, Jan. 27, from 11 a.m.- 2 p.m., La Casa Mobile Home Park Health Fair, 300 El Prado St. in North Port

The services offered at the 15 regularly established sites includes diabetes education and screening, blood pressure tests, pregnancy testing, HIV and tuberculosis testing, adult immunizations and health education. The staff also assists individuals who lack medical insurance and do not have a health care provider to find a medical home for ongoing health care.

No appointment is needed. Some services are free, including HIV rapid testing with results in 20 minutes. Other services are provided on a sliding-fee scale based on income. A registered nurse is available at all sites.
