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## **Mobile health services offered at 15 county sites and one special event during February**

The Sarasota County Health Department's Health In Motion Mobile Medical Unit staff will provide free and low-cost health services at 15 sites around the county during February. Staff also will be present at a special event:

- Monday, Feb. 6, from 9 a.m.- noon, Winter Residents' Appreciation Party  
Suncoast Business Concierge  
Venice Community Center, 326 Nokomis Ave. S., Venice.

The services offered at the 15 regularly established sites include diabetes education and screening, blood pressure tests, pregnancy testing, HIV and tuberculosis testing, adult immunizations and health education. The staff also assists individuals who lack medical insurance and do not have a health care provider to find a medical home for ongoing health care.

No appointment is needed. Some services are free, including HIV rapid testing with results in 20 minutes. Other services are provided on a sliding-fee scale based on income. A registered nurse is available at all sites.
