Mobile health services temporarily suspended in Sarasota County

The Florida Department of Health in Sarasota County is continuing with its transition to electronic medical records in all its clinics. This requires involvement from all nurses and other staff members, necessitating a temporary suspension of Health In Motion Mobile Unit services through the end of May. Health officials will continue to keep the public informed of changes to the schedule.
