Eligibility

Some services are available to everyone, regardless of income, such as children's immunizations. You may qualify for health care even if you are employed.

To determine your eligibility for services, you need to provide:

- Government photo ID
- Medical insurance, if you have it
- Social security card
- Income statement for last four weeks
- If in the U.S. on VISA, passport and I-94 card
