Health Department offering free H1N1 Flu Vaccine clinics to local businesses

The Sarasota County Health Department is offering free H1N1 flu vaccines at local offices or business sites. Health Department nurses will travel anywhere in Sarasota County to dispense free vaccine for groups of 20 or more. Families and children are welcome.

Although local incidents of flu illness have subsided, another wave of flu illness could cause excessive employee absenteeism, and disrupt workplace operations and productivity.
