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Local grants available for HIV/AIDS prevention projects and interventions

The Sarasota County Health and Human Services is accepting proposals for communitybased HIV/AIDS prevention projects and interventions targeted toward youth in Sarasota County.

Individual agencies may submit proposals up to a maximum of \$16,700. A collaboration of three agencies or more may apply for up to \$50,000.

HIV testing will be reimbursed at \$14 per test. No more than \$20,000 of the total \$50,000 in funding will be utilized for testing. The remaining \$30,000 must be used for prevention education services for high-risk youth and programs supporting behavioral change recommendations for those who are HIV positive.

Completed applications are due on or before 5 p.m. on October 29, 2010.
