Make plans to get tested on June 27 National HIV Testing Day

Free HIV testing will be available to the public at numerous locations from June 23-30 as part of the 16th annual National HIV Testing Day observance. HIV testing as well as syphilis, gonorrhea, blood pressure, glucose (blood sugar) and cholesterol screenings will be available in the Health In Motion Mobile Medical Unit, which will be parked at Siesta Beach on Friday, June 25, from 10 a.m.-3 p.m. Sponsoring organizations of this event include the Sarasota County Health Department, Community AIDS Network and ALSO Out Youth.

Many people who are HIV positive do not even know it. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), one out of five people living with HIV in the U.S. are unaware of their HIV status.

"Early diagnosis is the key. When I learned that I was HIV positive 20 years ago, I made positive lifestyle changes," said Valerie Wojciechowicz, a Sarasota resident who educates and advocates for women living with HIV. "Today, my quality of life is good even with HIV in part because of the early diagnosis and treatment."

The risk factors for HIV infection are having unprotected sex and sharing needles or syringes. If a person has never been tested, or has had unprotected sex or shared a needle since the last test, now is the time to get an HIV test. Knowing their HIV status can help persons get into medical treatment earlier, take steps to stay healthy and keep from spreading the virus to others.

HIV testing is fast and easy. People have a choice of getting the OraSure® HIV test or a traditional blood test. OraSure® testing consists of placing a treated cotton pad resembling a toothbrush between a person's cheek and gums for two minutes. It is easier than brushing your teeth. Several HIV testing sites provide the Rapid Ora Quick HIV Test, a finger stick, which provides preliminary test results in only 20 minutes. Test results are always kept private and are not shared with anyone, including family members, significant others, employers or landlords.

Local health department officials offer additional recommendations to reduce risk for HIV infection:

- **Be safe**: The best way to prevent HIV is to abstain from having sex. If a person does have sex, use a new condom every time. Do not share needles or syringes for any reason, whether to inject drugs (recreational or medical) or for tattoos and body piercing.
- Talk about it: Talk about sex and HIV with partners. Find out when they were last tested for HIV
 and their status. HIV is primarily spread through four fluids, semen, vaginal fluids, blood and
 breast milk.

• Talk to a doctor: If someone is sexually active, he or she should get tested for HIV at least once. Do not assume a doctor will suggest testing for HIV. Women who test positive should get treatment during all pregnancies and not breastfeed their babies.

Locally, the HIV/AIDS Network of Southwest Florida (HANS) works to raise awareness about HIV/AIDS at the grass-roots community level. The group meets monthly to coordinate HIV/AIDS prevention and outreach services throughout the region.
